

Looking to the Future.....

After presenting the strategic Plan document to DMOS COMIDE, the agency agreed in principle to draw up a five-year plan for the Province of Delhi starting in the year 2006. After collecting all relevant documents and information, the director and his team put in strenuous efforts and painstaking concentration for almost five months to prepare the various tool kits for different regions of the province, focusing on the over all socio-economic development of the people. The tool kits thus prepared was scrutinized by DMOS COMIDE team and they were presented to the Belgium Government for support and financial sanction. Finally, our plan was approved by the Belgium Government and the project was launched in 2006, initially starting in four centers. By 2007, the project covered all seven centers namely- Delhi, Najafgarh, Lucknow, Kauli, Ranchi, Chattisgarh and Kuarmunda.

Landless and Tribal communities

- Creating a curriculum more relevant to the present needs of the market.
- Training for youth and teachers in leadership, motivation, class room management.
- Focusing on the end result of all training namely "JOB FOR ALL TRAINEES".
- Job placement offices are set up in Delhi, Lucknow and Ranchi.
- A more systematic and planned approach for job placement is initiated.
- Most of the trainees are placed in good job through placement services.
