



## NCLEX-RN & IELTS Training & Placements

A venture that aims at providing better job prospects to qualified nurses who belong to less privileged class of society as well as other aspiring candidates who wish to pursue their career as a registered nurse abroad.

**Vision:** To assist well-qualified Indian nurses, working with diverse health care units in various parts of the country to get trained & placed into different health care units of United States of America.

**Training:** A qualified nurse has to pass National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) as the first step for applying for the placement to USA. Don Bosco-MARG in collaboration with Richard & Russel International (RRI) started training program on NCLEX-RN on 2nd February 2006. As on date, 90 students have successfully completed their coaching classes. Out of that, 21 students have already cleared NCLEX-RN (95% success rate) and are under various stages of visa processing, 32 students have received Eligibility to Test from various Boards of Nursing from USA and are waiting for their turn to write NCLEX-RN test.

The second step towards achieving a job placement in USA is clearing the IELTS test with a total band score of 6.5 and above. Therefore, this joint venture has also started imparting

English proficiency training with effect from 3rd September 2007.

The highlighting features of this training are:

- Interactive sessions including debates, group discussions, just a minute (JAM) & presentations on varied topics.
- Facilitating training in other soft skills to be better skilled individual and responsible citizens.
- Pre-scheduled seminars, viewing of English documentaries & films to enhance the language skills.
- A library that has been set up to improve the vocabulary & grammar of the candidates so that they have a good command over the language.
- LanguageLab, a Computer-aided Platform to equip the trainees in communication and language skills.

Besides this, we have training programmes in basic English Language skills (Spoken English) for the other streams as well which will ensure them better job prospects.
