



Remedial Classes

In 2002, BOSCO began Non-formal Education through coaching centers to provide quality education and for those who either had never been to school or who had dropped out of main stream educational institutions . These act as schools that prepare these drop-out students for entrance to main-stream schools.

After the school hours, remedial classes for 900 poor children are being organized at different places at Kauli, Jesola, Najafgarh, Lucknow, Ranchi and Jokhbala. The children perform well in their studies. Our study of these areas revealed that 75% children do not get time to complete their studies at home and therefore, these remedial classes are helping them in their studies. All the subjects are taught through these remedial classes. Students are provided with study materials and incentives for their performance.

As a result the number of school going children has increased and it has inculcated in them the habit of regularity in school attendance and strengthened their academic performance.

These remedial classes provide:

- A great help and support to the school going children.
- An atmosphere conducive to joyful learning.
- Flexibility in syllabus, activities based on child learning.
- A sense of realization to parents and children about the importance of education and what change it can bring into their lives to enhance their future.
- Competitive ability to these children and enable them to get admission in better schools due to their higher level of performance.
- Personality traits like self-respect, sociability, confidence, punctuality and hygienic living as part of their character formation.
- An exclusive blend of health and educational activities.
- Personal follow up and guidance to help the individual to grow.
- Trained teachers in their capacities as resource persons.

Parents are highly interested and enthusiastic to send their children to these centers and schools as they have realized the necessity of quality education especially the primary education for girls and boys. Moreover, the village leaders provide their complete support for this social development initiative.
