

SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION THROUGH INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT

(A Joint venture of BOSCO & DMOS COMIDE)

The Salesian Province of New Delhi has been one of the provinces to get this Programme Project approved towards integrated development taken up at the Provincial level. BOSCO Delhi, the Development Office played the pivotal role in conceptualizing this project with the clear mandate from the Provincial regime. Much effort and energy have gone into this, before the project was finally approved in collaboration with the Belgium Government which supported the project financially.

As the mandate was given to BOSCO, to draw up the plan and implement the programme at the Province level, from the very beginning it took various initiatives to introduce the concept of Participatory Statistical Plan (PSP) in the Province by conducting a number of seminars and workshops

on the concept of PSP for various stakeholders at different levels. The planning level went on for two years during which a lot of discussions, debate, field assessments, base line survey and deliberations took place and finally the strategic plan concept paper was prepared. The project plan was submitted to DMOS Comide in 2005 for their consideration and approval. The proposal was presented to Belgium Government by DMOS COMIDE as a co-financing project. Finally it was approved by the Belgium Government through the intervention and support of DMOS COMIDE in 2006. The duration of the project is 5 years i.e. 2006-2010.
